Dear Parents/Carers

This will ensure parents see what their child has eaten.

Next week we will be marking Safer Internet Day with a theatre performance on Friday for the children. The show will look at cyber bullying and the impact it has on children. 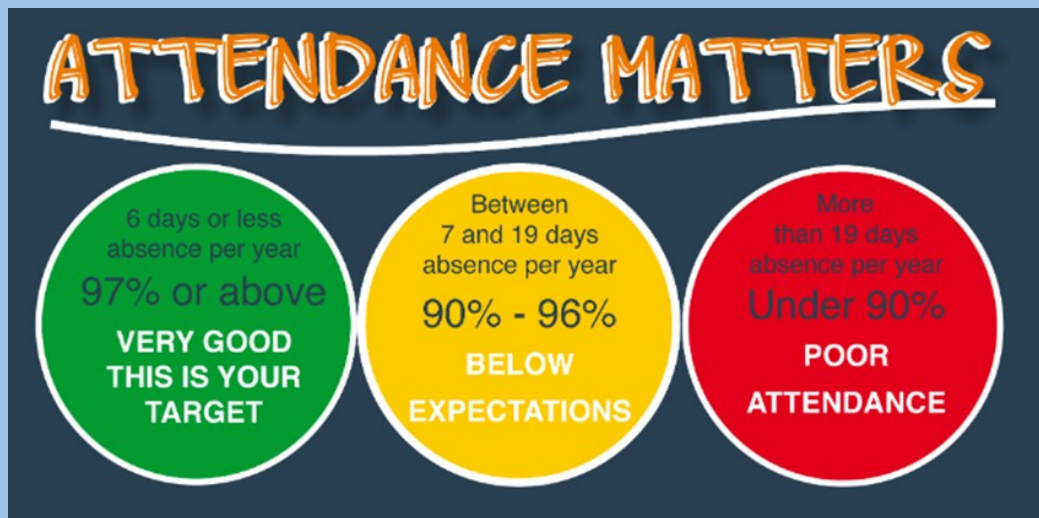
