

Key Knowledge/Skills

- Join 2D shapes to make a 3D form.
- Join larger pieces of materials, exploring what gives 3D shapes stability.
- Shape card in different ways eg. rolling, folding and choose the best way to recreate a drawn idea.
- Identify and draw negative spaces.
- Plan a sculpture by drawing.
- Choose materials to scale up an idea.
- Create different joins in card eg. slot, tabs, wrapping.
- Add surface detail to a sculpture using colour or texture.
- Display sculpture.

Artist Information

Anthony Caro (1924-2013): A British artist who made abstract sculptures. He used scrap metal and found objects. Some of his sculptures are colourful.

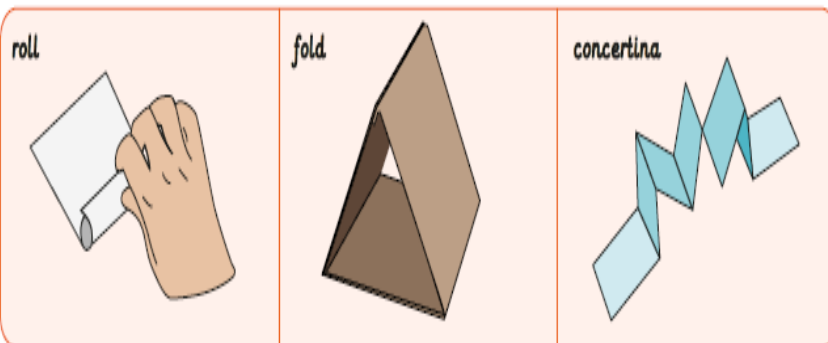
Ruth Asawa (1926-2013): An American sculpture who made wire sculptures. She was interested in the shapes created by space between artworks.
