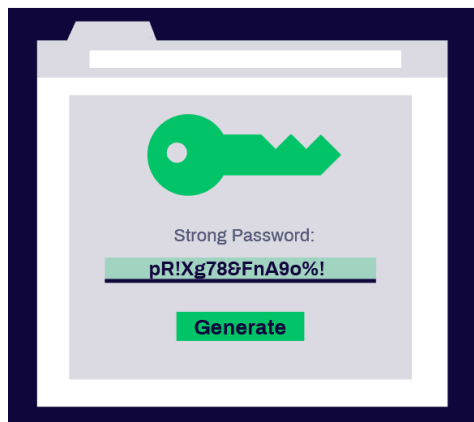
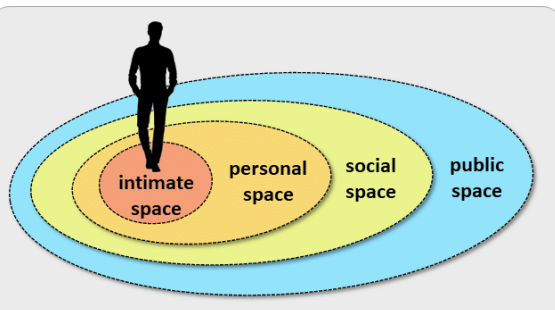


## Relationships 2

In this topic, pupils will consider respectful behaviours, privacy and personal boundaries. They will understand the steps they need to take if someone is treating them in a way that makes them uncomfortable. Pupils will consider ways to keep themselves safe online.



## Key knowledge and threads

### Key thread: Relationships

- Know that their personal space is private to them
- Know that they must treat people how they would like to be treated (in person and online)
- Know that they must tell someone if their behaviour is crossing their personal boundaries
- Know that people can imitate others online and to tell a trusted adult and ignore the person if they encounter this
- Know that they need high-security passwords and privacy setting to keep themselves safe from people online
- Know that their digital footprint is the information about them that exists on the internet because of their online activity.



## Vocabulary Abstract

**Privacy**—not being observed or disturbed by others

**Respect**—due regard for the feelings, wishes, or rights of others

**Personal space**—physical space immediately surrounding someone, into which encroachment can feel threatening or uncomfortable.

**Personal boundaries**—limits and rules we set for ourselves within relationships

**Digital footprint**—information about a particular person that exists on the internet
