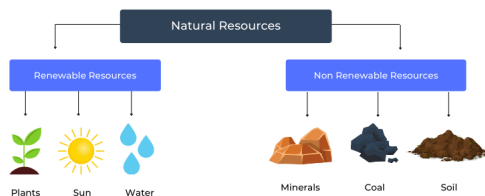


Living in the Wider World 1

This unit will focus on compassion and shared responsibility within a community. Pupils will know different ways of showing care for others as well as ways to share responsibility towards good causes. Pupils will explore the ways data is used online and what inappropriate uses are.



Key knowledge and threads

Key thread: Living in the Wider World

- Know that it is important to show compassion towards others
- Know ways to show care and concern for others through being accepting, listening, showing appreciation
- Know that we have a shared responsibilities to care for other people and living things
- Know that sustainable companies try to conserve natural resources
- Know that it is important to protect the environment
- Know that using vehicles, electricity, not recycling waste damages the environment
- Know that recycling, saving electricity, walking/cycling places benefits the environment
- Know that they must show compassion for the environment, animals and other living things
- Know that they have a responsibility to dispose of waste through recycling and waste bins
- Know that they have a responsibility to not contaminate land, water, vegetation and air
- Know that information on the internet is ranked, selected and targeted at specific individuals and groups
- Know that connected devices can share information
- Know that inappropriate things to share online are offensive, misleading or explicit rules surrounding distribution of images
- Know that text and images in the media and on social media can be manipulated or invented
- Know that strategies to evaluate the reliability of sources and identify misinformation are checking the author and their credentials and if the information matches similar articles



Vocabulary Abstract

Natural Resources—materials or substances found in nature which can be used for economic gain

Environment—the natural world

Compassion—the feeling when you see others suffering, and want to help them

Responsibility—something you have to do

Inappropriate—not suitable for the situation

Reliability—how trustworthy something or someone is
